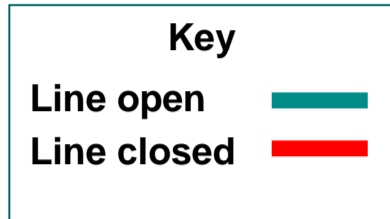
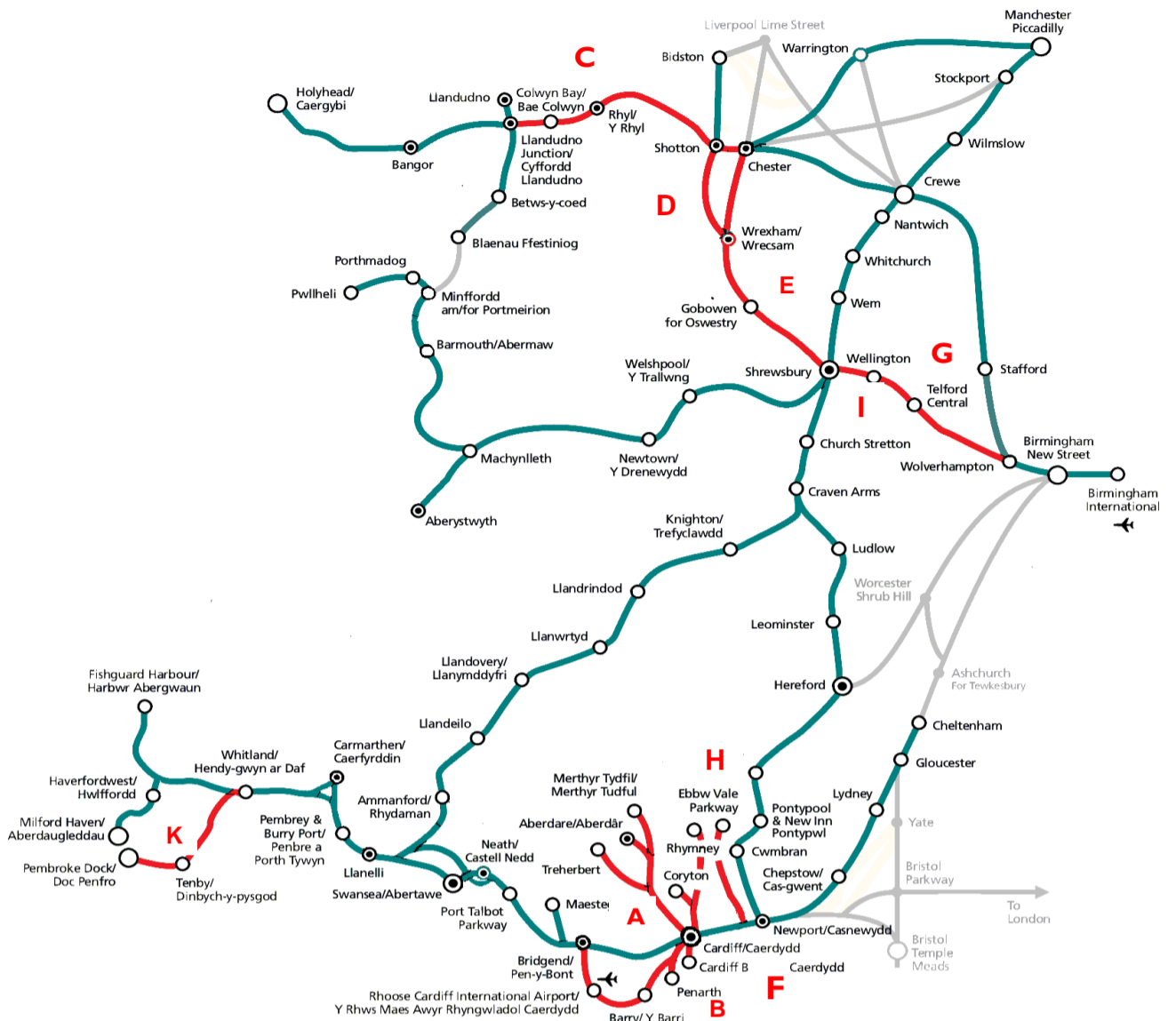


April 2017 Changes to Train Times



Passengers are reminded that some late night and early morning journeys may also be subject to change across our network and are advised to check before travelling.

Please ensure you have purchased a ticket before boarding rail replacement road transport services.



Major engineering work taking place during April on the Arriva Trains Wales network at the locations detailed below. These are changes to the published timetable. A Valley Lines.

Saturday 1 and Sunday 2 April.

Due to a major engineering project taking place on these dates. There will be disruption to all Valley Lines services. For details of altered services and replacement bus services passengers are advised to see posters at their local station and on the Arriva Trains Wales and National Rail Enquiries websites.

B Cardiff and Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend on the 'Vale of Glamorgan' line.

Sunday 2 and 9 April.

A replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff Central and Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

C Chester to Llandudno Junction.

Sunday 2 April.

Buses will replace trains between Chester and Llandudno Junction. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

D Shotton High Level to Bidston.

Sunday 2 April.

Buses will replace trains between Shotton High Level and Bidston on the Wrexham to Bidston line. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

E Shrewsbury to Chester.

Sunday 9 April.

Rail services between Shrewsbury and Chester will be diverted and a replacement bus service will be in operation between Shrewsbury and Chester. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

F Cardiff Queen Street to Cardiff Central.

Sunday 9 April.

Until 1230, trains will be diverted via the 'City Line' to Cardiff Central. There will be no Cardiff to Rhymney or Cardiff Queen St to Cardiff Bay train services. Replacement bus services will be in place between Radyr and Cardiff Central and Rhymney and Cardiff Central. After 1230, there will be no train services between Cardiff Queen Street and Cardiff Central. Trains services will start and terminate at Cardiff Queen Street and Cardiff Bay. Replacement bus services will be in operation between Cardiff Central and Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

G Albrighton Railway Station.

Saturday 8 April to Monday 24 April.

During this period Albrighton station will be closed. Passengers wishing to access the train services should travel to/from Albrighton Station on the shuttle bus services between Codsall, Albrighton and Cosford. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

H Cardiff Central and Ebbw Vale Parkway.

Sunday 16 April.

Until 1330, buses replace trains between Cardiff Central and Ebbw Vale Parkway. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

I Shrewsbury to Wolverhampton.

Saturday 15, Sunday 16 and Monday 17 April.

On these dates there will be no train services between Shrewsbury and Wolverhampton. A replacement bus service will be in operation at this time.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

J Cardiff and Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend on the 'Vale of Glamorgan' line.

Sunday 23 April until 1230.

A replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff Central and Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

K Whitland to Pembroke Dock.

Monday 24 to Friday 28 April.

Buses will replace trains on the Pembroke Dock line between Whitland and Pembroke Dock. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

We regret that bicycles, prams and animals (except assistance dogs) cannot be carried on rail replacement road transport.
