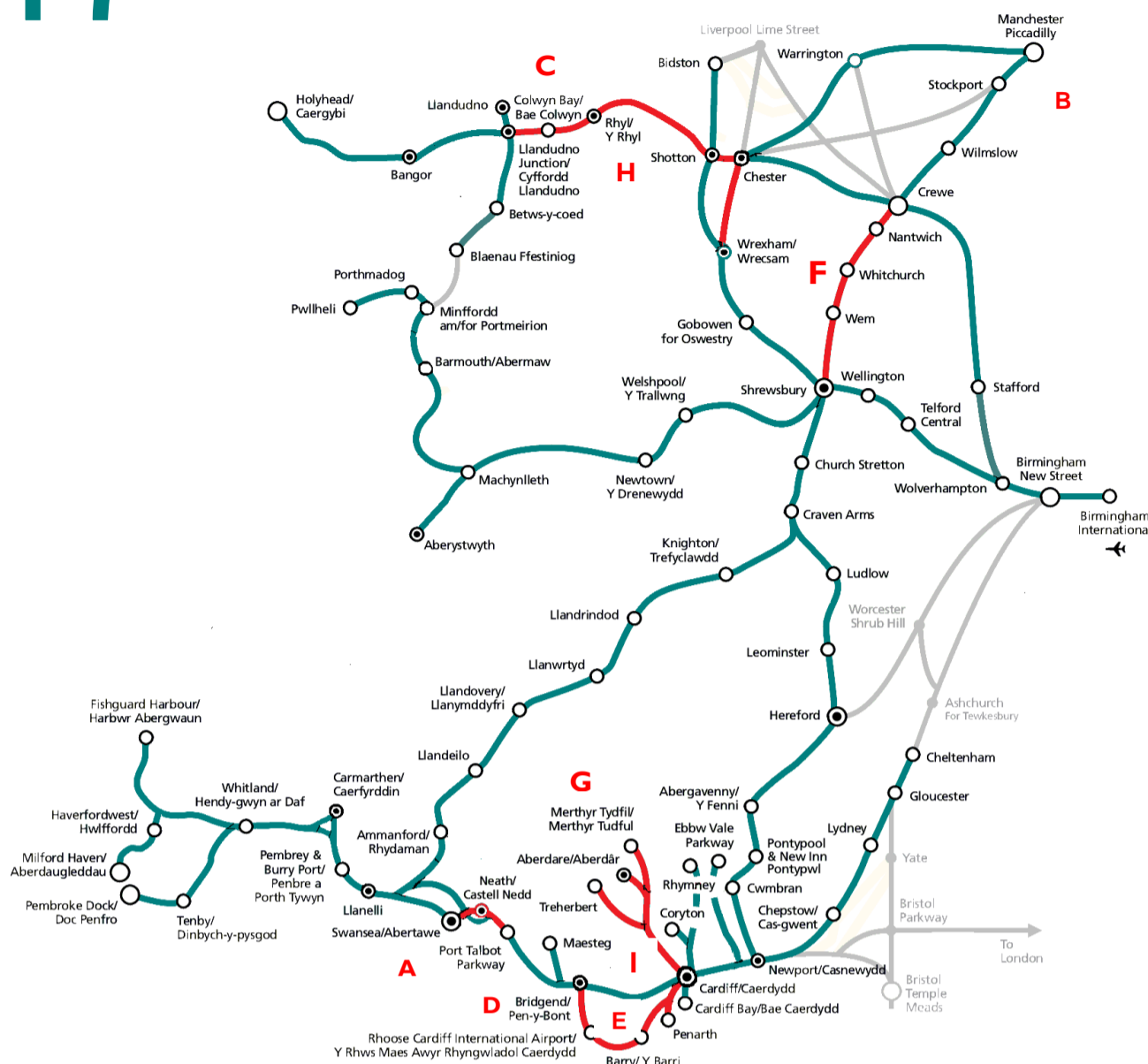

Major engineering work taking place during March on the Arriva Trains Wales network at the locations detailed below. These are changes to the published timetable. - A Port Talbot Parkway to Swansea.**
Saturday 4. Sundays 5, 12, 19 and 26 March.
A replacement bus service will be in operation between Port Talbot Parkway and Swansea. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.
- B Manchester Piccadilly and Manchester Airport.**
Saturdays 4 and 11 March.
Buses will replace trains between Manchester Piccadilly and Manchester Airport calling at East Didsbury. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.
- C Chester to Llandudno Junction.**
Sundays 5, 19 and 26 March.
Buses will replace trains between Chester and Llandudno Junction. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.
- D Rhoose and Bridgend.**
Sunday 5, 12 and 19 March.
Buses will replace trains between Rhoose and Bridgend, buses will connect into and out of trains travelling to and from Cardiff Central. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.
- E Cardiff and Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend on the 'Vale of Glamorgan' line.**
Sunday 12 March until 1230.
Sunday 26 March all day.
A replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff Central and Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

- F Shrewsbury and Crewe.**
Saturday 11 and Sunday 12 March.
Trains will be diverted with a replacement bus service calling at intermediate stations between Shrewsbury and Crewe. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.
- G Radyr and Treherbert, Aberdare and Merthyr Tydfil.**
Sunday 19 March.
A replacement bus service will be in operation between Radyr and Treherbert, Aberdare and Merthyr Tydfil until 1230. A replacement bus service will be in operation between Pontypridd and Treherbert after 1230. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.
- H Chester to Wrexham/Rhyl.**
From Friday 24 March at 2200, to Friday 31 April 2017.
Major engineering work will be taking place affecting travel between Wrexham, Chester and Rhyl. Replacement bus services will be in operation during this period. For further details please see posters at your local station and on the Arriva Trains Wales and National Rail Enquiries websites. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.
- I Cardiff Central and Cardiff Queen St**
Pontypridd and Treherbert
Sunday 26 March.
There will be no train services between Cardiff Central and Cardiff Queen St. Trains will start and terminate at Cardiff Queen St. A replacement bus service will also be in operation between Pontypridd and Treherbert. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.
