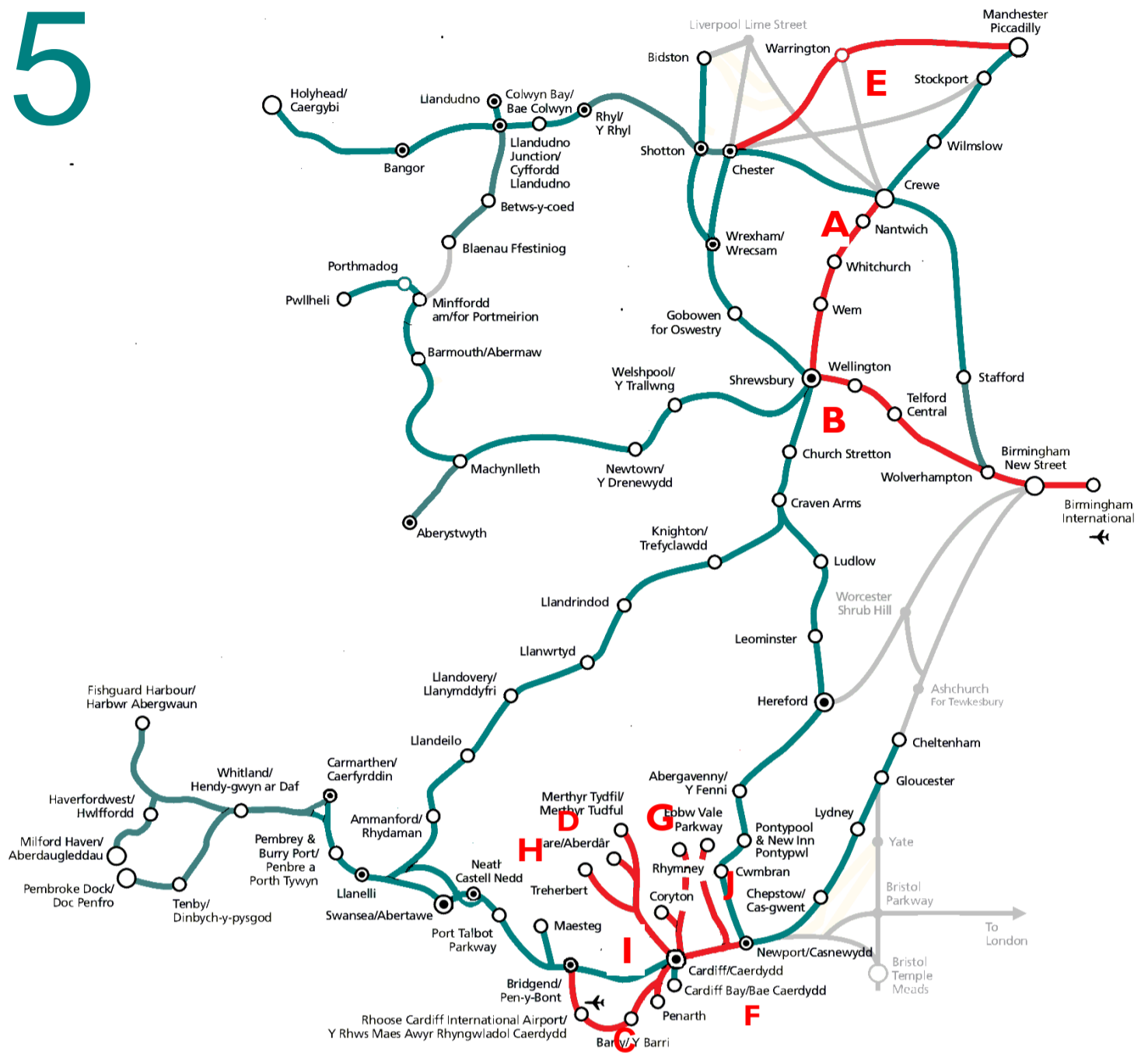

Major engineering work will be taking place during May on the Arriva Trains Wales network at the locations detailed below and this will result in changes to the published timetable. **A Shrewsbury to Crewe.**  
**Sunday 3 May**

Trains to be diverted via an alternate route. Replacement bus services between Shrewsbury and Crewe. Some services will run to/from Manchester via Warrington Bank Quay. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

**B Shrewsbury and Birmingham.**  
**Sunday 3 and Monday 4 May**

All day Sunday and Monday buses will replace trains between Shrewsbury and Birmingham. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

**C Cardiff Central to Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend via the VOG.**  
**Sunday 10 May until 0930.**

A replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff Central and Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

**D Cardiff Central to Merthyr Tydfil, Aberdare and Treherbert.**  
**Sunday 17 May until 1230.**

A replacement bus service will be in operation between Radyr and Merthyr Tydfil, Aberdare and Treherbert. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

**E Manchester to Chester**  
**Sunday 24 May until 1600.**

Trains between Manchester and Chester will be diverted and unable to call at intermediate stations, a replacement bus service will be in operation calling at all intermediate stations. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

**F Cardiff Central to Newport**  
**Saturday 23 to Monday 25 May**

On Saturday and Monday trains to/from Holyhead will run between Newport and Holyhead and trains to/from Cheltenham will run as far as Gloucester (passengers to travel with other train operators). All weekend, Ebbw Vale trains will run between Ebbw Vale Parkway and Newport (passengers to travel on first available service between Newport and Cardiff). On Sunday, buses between Cardiff Central and Pye Corner are also provided. All trains are subject to retiming earlier and/or later throughout. On Sunday, buses replace all trains between Cardiff and Newport until 1000. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

**G Cardiff Central and Rhymney**  
**Sunday 31 May until 1200**

A replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff and Rhymney at this time. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

**H Pontypridd and Treherbert**  
**Saturday 30 and Sunday 31 May**

A replacement bus service will be in operation between Pontypridd and Treherbert at this time. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

**I Cardiff Central and Radyr**  
**Sunday 31 May until 1230**

Trains between Cardiff Central and Merthyr Tydfil/Aberdare/Pontypridd will be diverted via the City Line, A replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff and Radyr. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

**J Cardiff Central and Ebbw Vale**  
**Sunday 31 May**

On Sunday, the Cardiff Central to Ebbw Vale train service will run between Newport and Ebbw Vale Parkway (passengers to travel on first available service between Newport and Cardiff). A replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff Central and Pye Corner. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.
